

Tax Exemption Procedures

Designated procedures must be completed when applying for tax exemption on purchased products. 免税で購入する際は、所定の手続きが必要になります。

Eligible Persons 対象者

Non-residents 非居住者



Foreign (non-Japanese) nationals who have entered Japan within the last six months (excluding persons working in a Japan-based office)

Japanese persons residing overseas who have temporarily returned to and been in Japan for less than six months

Required Documentation 必要書類



Applicant's passport, other relevant documentation

Procedures 手続き方法



When you purchase the product(s), show your passport and other relevant documentation.

商品購入時に、ご本人のパスポート等をご提示ください。



Please take this checklist explanation.

Pay the tax free price.

Consumables will be packed in a specified bag or box and given to you. Do not open this bag/box until after you have left Japan.

Please present your passport and purchased items at customs when leaving the country.

Tax-exempt Product Categories 免税商品の区別

General Items

Purchase total for a single day in the same store:

¥5,000 or more (tax excluded)









Clothing Bags and shoes

Gifts and souvenirs

However, if general goods are wrapped so that they can not be used in Japan, spending for general goods may be combined with spending for consumables. In this case, applicable requirements are the same as those for consumables.

Please present your passport and purchased items at customs

when leaving the country. 出国の際にパスポート等と購入物品を税関に提示してください。

Important Considerations Before Purchasing ご購入前のご注意

Tax exemption is not possible for persons who do not present their passport and other relevant documentation.

ご本人のパスポート等がない場合は免税できません。

If you enter Japan through an automated entry gate or similar, you must receive a stamp in your passport verifying your entry date in order to apply for tax exemption.

自動化ゲートを通って入国した場合など、スタンプがない場合は入国日を証明するものがないため 免税販売できません。

If you use a credit card, the name on your passport and other relevant documentation must match the name on your credit card. クレジットカードご利用の際は、名義がパスポート等と一致であることが必須です。

Items purchased on the day of application are eligible for tax exemption. 当日販売したものが免税になります。

Each country prohibits the bringing in of certain items (for example, meats, fruits, and items in violation of the Washington Convention (CITES)). 国により持ち込めない物品(例:肉類、果実類、 ワシントン条約に抵触するもの)があります。

Purchase total for a single day in the same store:

Between ¥5,000 and ¥500,000 (tax excluded)

Consumables may not be used while you are in Japan. 消耗品は日本滞在中は使用できません。

Important Considerations After Purchasing ご購入後のご注意

Please present your passport and purchased items at customs at the airport or port when leaving the country.

出国時は空港や港の税関で、パスポート等と購入物品を提示してください。

When leaving Japan, please consult with airport customs regarding items that are prohibited as carry-on baggage on the airplane before completing flight check-in procedures.

飛行機に持ち込めない物品は出国する際、搭乗便のチェックインをする前に 空港の税関にお問い合わせください。

You will be required to pay consumption tax at customs when leaving the country for any tax-exempted items you consume before leaving Japan. 免税で購入された消耗品を国内で消費した場合は、出国時の税関で 消費税をお支払いただきますのでご注意ください。
